This book is a collection of 30 case studies, which were published in the Singapore Medical Journal from 1994 to 1997. They include interesting cases from all the major anatomical regions and organ systems. This book is, however, not intended as a comprehensive collection of clinical cases but rather illustrative examples of the role of diagnostic radiology in patient management.

The original case studies have been rewritten and presented in the form of case quizzes. The common layout of each study is an initial case presentation followed by image interpretation, diagnosis, clinical course and discussion.

The aim of the book is to present case studies to the family physicians and trainees in various medical specialties. This book is also suitable for basic trainees in diagnostic radiology. For this intended purpose, the cases selected appear well chosen, illustrated and discussed. Each case turned out to be an excellent exposition of the clinical and radiological features of the disease entity under study. Although not primarily intended for the specialist radiologist, nevertheless, the materials do make interesting reading, especially the clinical aspects.

The author is a professor in the Department of Diagnostic Radiology, Queen Mary Hospital, University of Hong Kong. He is actively involved in teaching and has produced numerous articles of educational value. This latest contribution will further strengthen his position as a teacher of diagnostic radiology in this region.
