THE SIR JAMES FRASER TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIP

The Fellowship will be awarded to Fellows or Members of the College in good standing working in Singapore, Sabah or Sarawak to enable them to visit the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh, to attend a Surgical Congress in the UK and to enable them to visit medical centres in Scotland by arrangement.

Funding will be £1500 and awarded biennially. This will cover an airfare and some subsistence during the visit. The College will provide accommodation on its campus (up to a maximum of 7days).

The Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh collects personal data from you during the application process for Awards and Grants. We will not share this information with any third parties, and your data will be used solely for the purpose of processing and administrating this application.

Applicants must submit a copy of their curriculum vitae no more than 5 pages and two letters of reference, together with a statement of not more than 1000 words as to why they would like to take advantage of the Fellowship, to:
